## **Fall Funding Windows**

- Open: Oct. 6 at 8 am to 20 at 5 pm
- While we want to fund all graduate students, we unfortunately cannot as we have a limited budget. We operate on a first come, first serve basis and on application accuracy. Funding is not guaranteed
- Application instructions
- Two possible funds to apply for: Research Capstone Fund
- Professional Development Fund
  - o Professional Development Fund (PDF) Virtual Conference Application
    - Being a presenter is not required
    - What you need
      - Letter of support from faculty advisor
      - Student reimbursement form (found on GSA website)
      - Receipt of conference, itemized list of costs
      - Proof of attendance (conference at a glance, schedule, etc).
        - For international students: need NRA001, NRA002, or 1-55 1
          Form
    - Only applications from a represented department will be accepted
  - o Professional Development Fund (PDF) In-Person Application
    - Fill out TRV-1 Form Correctly (found on GSA website)

- Carefully watch the pre-recorded videos on GSA's website; select "business" as your purpose of travel
- PDF of an email from advisor/supervisor saying they have pre-approved your travel and business purpose of attendance
- Letter of support from your faculty advisor (explicitly stating what business purpose you have attending)
- Itemized receipt of conference costs
  - If you have not attended conference yet: submit estimated costs; travel will be tentatively funded; send your receipts to your department's funding person not to GSA's treasurer, Clair Newman
- Proof of conference: schedule at a glance/thank you for attending email, etc.
- Presentation abstract
- If you are NOT a US citizen: NRA-001, NRA-002, or 1-551 form
- The funds are technically by amount allocated, not by number of students
  - For example, if every student only gets \$100 for PDF, another 40 students could also be granted \$100
- Research Capstone Fund (RCF)
  - Up to \$300 to spend on whatever you need to complete your research (not your advisors)
  - o This is a reimbursement to your department NOT you
    - Some departments will pick up additional funding
    - Students can go in together to get more funding (so 2 students = \$600)
  - The following does not qualify for RCF
    - Furniture, cash/cash advance gifts, subject/participant payment, dissertation binding, any request over \$300
